Policy	<p>Administration must not deny enrollment or otherwise discriminate in admission practices on the basis of a child’s need for special education or supplementary aids or services.</p> <p>Administration shall comply with the Board’s Student Admissions Policy which has been adopted by the Board of Trustees. Administration is further directed to make Admissions Policy available for inspection by auditors from the Pennsylvania Department of Education during any special education cyclical monitoring audit.</p> <p>Administration shall comply with Section 24 P.S. 17-1723-A of the Charter School Law regarding enrollment and shall not discriminate in its admission policies or practices on the basis of intellectual ability (except to the extent specifically allowed by law), or athletic ability, measures of achievement or aptitude, status as a person with a disability, proficiency in the English language or any other basis that would be illegal under applicable state and/or federal laws or regulations.</p>
Delegation of Responsibility	The Board of Trustees of Seven Generations Charter School authorizes the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or his/her designee to enforce this policy
