Policy	The timeframe for completion of private physical and dental exams is extended to allow Seven Generations Charter School to accept private physical and dental exam reports completed within one year prior to a student’s entry into the grade where an exam is required.
Delegation of Responsibility	The Board of Trustees of Seven Generations Charter School authorizes the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or his/her designee to enforce this policy
Background	Many parents/guardians elect to have their child’s dental and health exam done privately. However, the Pennsylvania Public School Code also requires that private exams be completed within four months of the beginning of the designated school year. For some parents who elect to do private exams, as well as for the physicians, dentists and schools, this time constraint has become difficult. It often results in unnecessary examinations, lost time for parents and practitioners, additional expenses for families, and added paperwork for schools.
