Policy	<p>This policy gives notice that the Board of Trustees of Seven Generations Charter School (the “Charter School”) hereby adopts this policy in order to uphold dress and grooming standards for the health, safety and welfare of the school community. The Board of Trustees has established that students, along with their families, are expected to make responsible choices about what clothes they wear to school and that such choices should be in alignment with the values/beliefs of the Charter School community. Students’ attire should also support daily learning time outside. Students are required to dress appropriately for the weather conditions and should wear washable, comfortable clothes that allow them to work and move freely.</p> <p>The Board of Trustees directs the administration to assist families in need of assistance in obtaining appropriate school attire. Students have the responsibility to keep themselves, their clothes and hair clean. School officials may impose limitations on student participation in the regular instructional program when there is evidence that the lack of cleanliness constitutes a health hazard.</p>
