Policy	<p>A student who is eligible to attend Seven Generations Charter School (“School”) and is married and/or pregnant shall not be denied an educational program solely because of marriage, pregnancy, pregnancy-related disabilities, or potential or actual parenthood.</p> <p>The Board reserves the right to require as a prerequisite for attendance in the regular classes and participation in co-curricular/noncurricular activities, written certification from a licensed physician that such activity will not be injurious to her health nor jeopardize her pregnancy. The School will not honor a request for the voluntary exclusion or excusal of a pregnant student unless the request is accompanied by written certification from the attending physician that class attendance or other educational program alternatives, including homebound instruction, during pregnancy would be harmful to the student's physical or mental health.</p>
Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The CEO or designee shall develop procedures for the implementation of this policy which include offering counseling services to help students plan their future and cooperating with community resources to assist students.</p>
Guidelines	<p>A pregnant student whose mental or physical condition prevents her from attending regular classes, when such condition is certified by a licensed physician, may be assigned to an alternate educational program in her home school district.</p> <p>A student who has received an alternate educational program for reasons associated with her pregnancy shall be readmitted to the regular school program upon her request and the written statement of a licensed physician that she is physically fit to do so.</p>
